## The Project

The Project MKII is an initiative that has been developed by The South Cotswold Partnership and Connexions Gloucestershire. This will provide additional support to pupils at the end of Key Stage 3 and throughout Key Stage 4 in order for them to make an informed choices in the future whether it is education or training.

The Project MKII has been designed to be interactive to enable pupils to develop crucial skills that every young person will need and match employers requirements. These include communication and team work skills.

Pupils who are taking part in the initiative attend partner schools and will be working together throughout the length of the initiative.

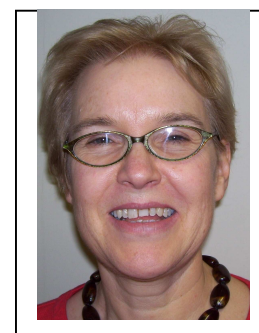

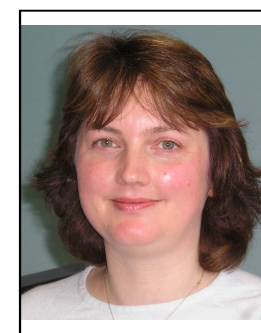
